Should we choose the Student Health Insurance Plan for our Student?

It is the policy of the University of Connecticut that full-time students have health insurance. A Student Health Insurance Plan (SHIP) is offered by the University and if you have other health insurance, you have the right to waive the school offered plan by going to www.studentadmin.uconn.edu and accessing the online-health insurance waiver form.

We encourage you to review your health insurance against the University offered plan. It is possible that, for many students, the SHIP may be a better investment and offer a wider availability for care.
